2018 Annual Report



In the 11 years since Melanie first returned from Africa, our sites in Kenya and Uganda have grown tremendously. The successes of 2018 were made possible by generous donors who believe in our mission and have a strong desire to change the lives of two communities a world away. This year EACH raised \$50,000, which directly supported school sponsorships and classroom construction.

At the Good Hope Initiative in Uganda, the “Pioneers” completed their 2nd year of secondary school, and are continuing to provide an example for the children following their lead in primary school and for their community as well. In addition to sponsorships of the GHI pioneers, EACH was able to provide the remaining funding to complete the construction of two classrooms at Good Hope. This brings the total number of permanent classrooms at Good Hope to eight! These classrooms allow the primary school kids at Good Hope to learn in a clean, dry, quiet environment, that is conducive to learning.

At Upendo in Kenya, EACH was able to send 12 girls to secondary school, 3 girls to college and educate 158 children through the primary school. Educating the girls through their secondary education and now college gives them the foundation they need to build successful futures they otherwise wouldn't have had without our generous supporters. All of these young women are also setting a wonderful example for their sisters still living at Upendo.

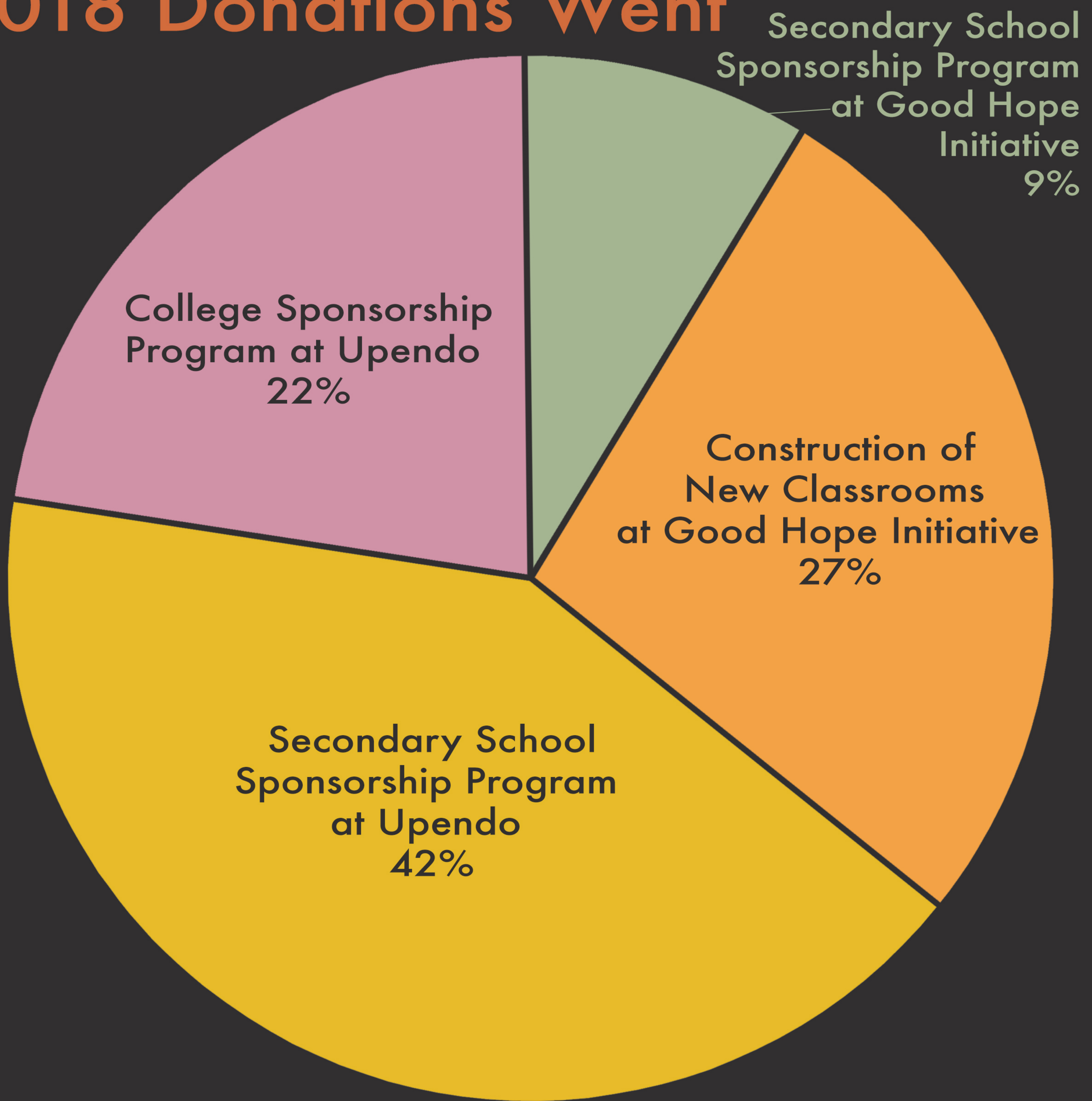
We have big plans for our sites in 2019. Five of our girls in Kenya will be continuing their college education while eight EACH sponsored girls are pursuing their secondary education. In Uganda, our “pioneers” will continue their quest for education while EACH begins construction of five more permanent classrooms for the primary school.

As we look back over the past 11 years, we reflect upon what EACH has accomplished. We have built over a dozen classrooms and supported the education of over a thousand children, we are overjoyed by the consistent support of our sponsors. Many of you have been following EACH's journey from the beginning. None of this would be possible without your support and encouragement so from New York to East Africa, we thank you. Your impact will be felt for years to come.

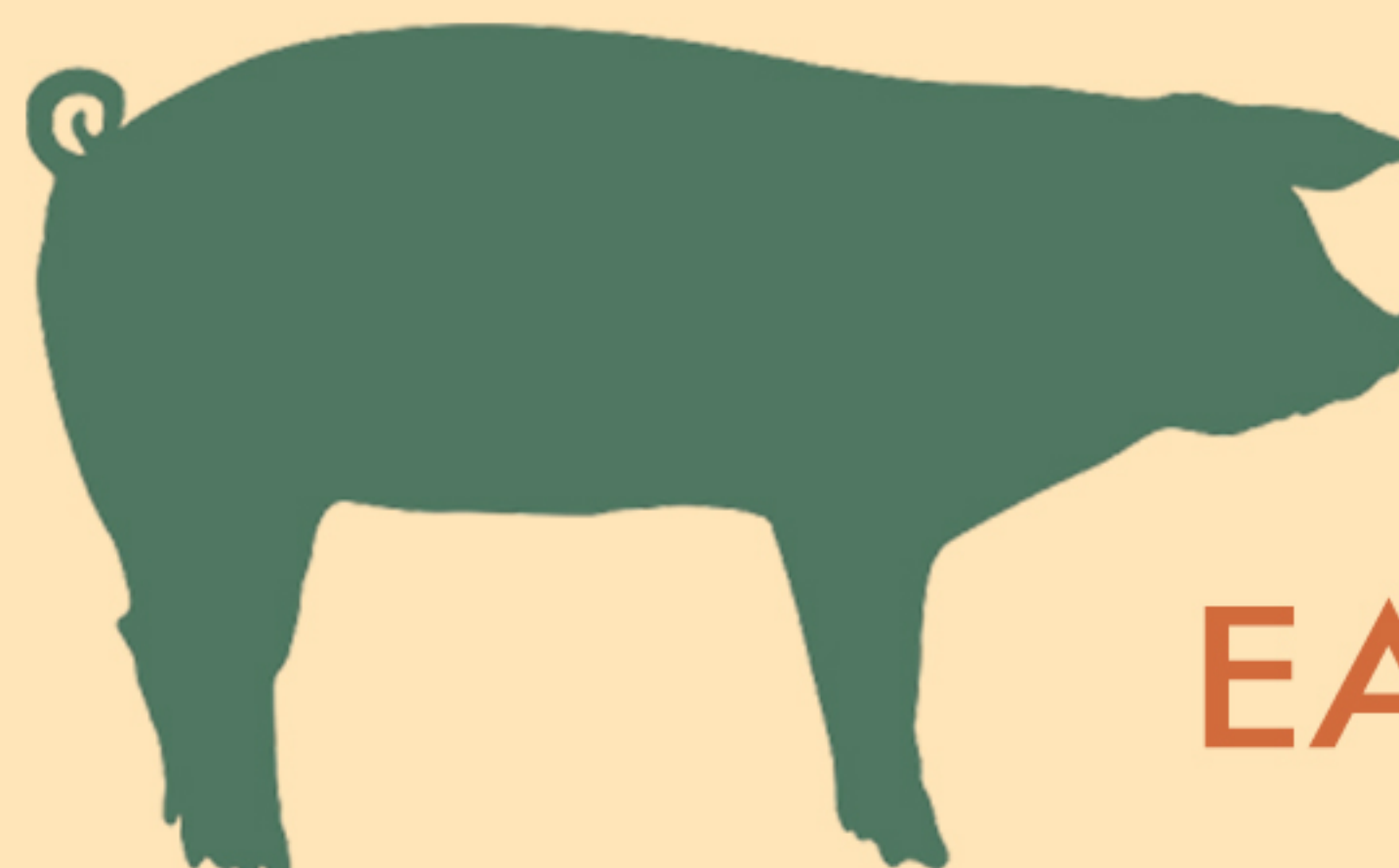

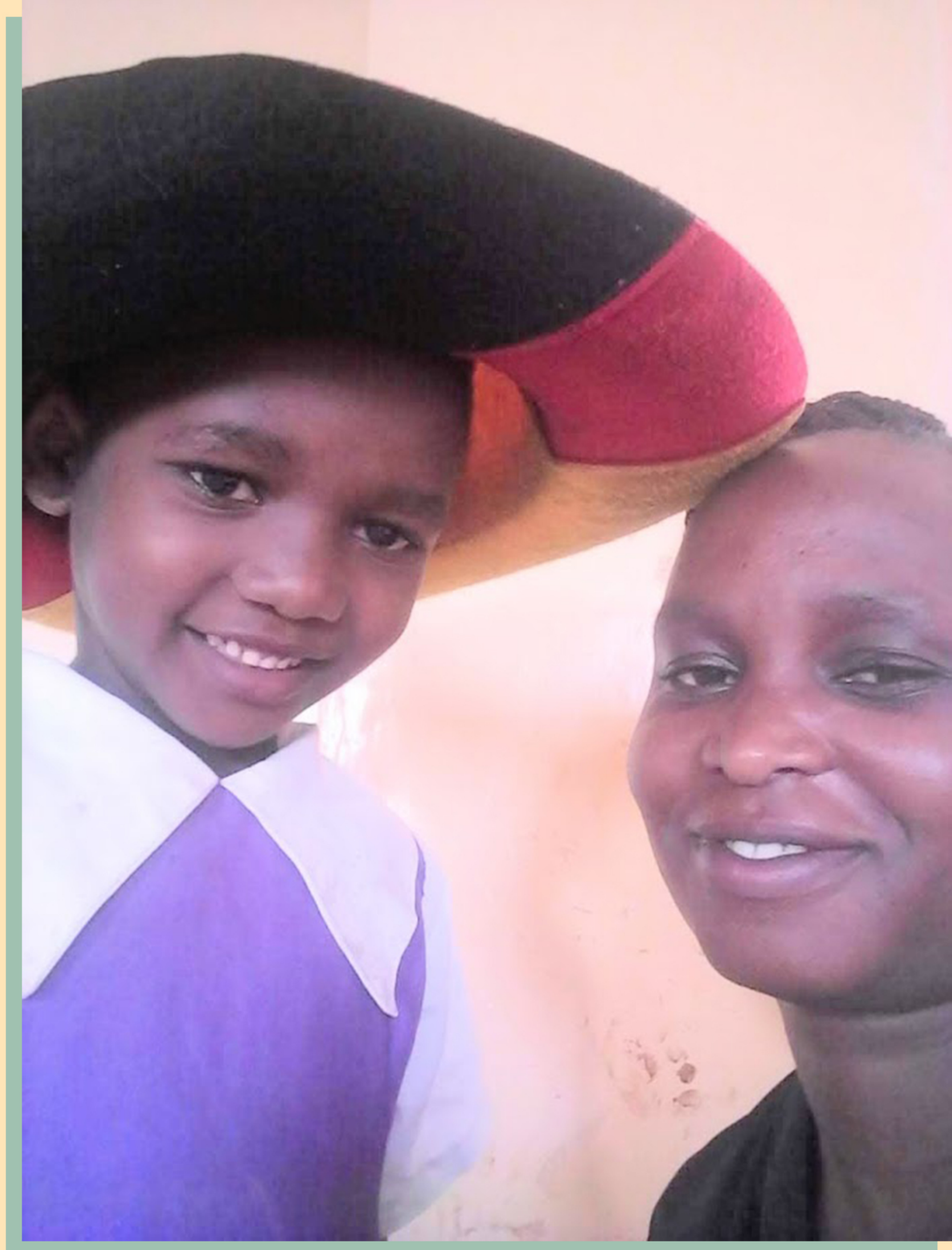
